RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE SUBMISSION OF LEVY

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF MASON COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT NO. 13, PROVIDING FOR THE SUBMISSION TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE DISTRICT AT THE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD WITHIN THE DISTRICT ON NOVEMBER 5, 2013 OF A PROPOSITION AUTHORIZING A LEVY OF A PROPERTY TAX NOT TO EXCEED \$1.00 PER \$1,000.00 OF TRUE AND ASSESSED VALUATION SUBJECT TO OTHERWISE APPLICABLE STATUTORY LIMITATIONS.

Background: WHEREAS, it is the judgment of the Board of Commissioners of the District that it is essential and necessary for the protection of the health and life of the residents of the District that fire services be provided by the District. The accelerated demands for, and increasing costs of, providing this service will necessitate the expenditure of revenues for maintenance, operations and equipment in excess of those which can be provided by the District's regular tax revenue levied at the current rate per \$1,000.00 of assessed valuation of taxable property within the District as limited by the 101% limitation.

Resolution: NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Mason County Fire Protection District No. 13, Mason County, Washington as follows:

Section 1. In order to provide fire protection and prevention in the District, it is necessary for the District to obtain, operate and maintain emergency fire vehicles and facilities staffed by properly trained personnel equipped with suitable firefighting equipment and to maintain personnel.

Section 2. In order to provide the revenue adequate to pay the costs of providing adequate life protection services and facilities as described in Section 1 and to assure the continuation of such services, the District shall, in accordance with RCW 84.55.050, remove the limitation on regular property taxes imposed by RCW 84.55.010, and levy beginning in 2013 and collecting beginning in 2014, pursuant to RCW 52.16.130, RCW 52.16.140 and RCW 52.16.160, a general tax on taxable property within the District at a rate of \$1.00 per \$1,000.00 of assessed valuation subject to otherwise applicable statutory limits.

Section 3. The District currently levies a regular property tax at the rate of approximately \$0.78 per \$1,000.00 of assessed valuation. The amount levied in 2013 shall serve as the District's tax levy base for purposes of applying the limit factor by RCW 84.55.010 in subsequent years.

Section 4. There shall be submitted to the qualified electors of the District for their ratification or rejection, at a general election on November 5, 2013, the question of whether or not the regular property tax levy of the District should be restored to \$1.00 per \$1,000.00 of true and assessed valuation, subject to otherwise applicable statutory limitations. The Board of Commissioners hereby requests the auditor of Mason County, as ex-officio Supervisor of Elections, to call such special election, and to submit the

following proposition at such election, in the form of a ballot title substantially as follows:

Mason County Fire Protection District No. 13 – Board of Commissioners –
Proposition Authorizing Property Tax Levy.


The Board of Commissioners of Mason County Fire Protection District No. 13 adopted Resolution No. 242 concerning a proposition to restore its regular property tax levy for maintenance and operations to an amount not to exceed \$1.00 per \$1,000.00 of assessed valuation to be levied in 2013 for collection in 2014. The maximum allowable levy in 2013 shall serve as the base for computing subsequent levy limitation as provided by chapter 84.55 RCW.
